Ready to swing? Registration is finalized once we receive your form and payment. Space is limited for drums, piano, bass, and guitar; register early to secure a spot.

The Kicks Band of Fargo Moorhead is pleased to announce open registration for musicians with two or more years of band experience. All wind instruments are accepted, including flute, clarinet, euphonium, etc. Early registration is recommended.

Jazz Campers will perform in a jazz band/combo with others at a similar playing level, attend masterclasses, study jazz improvisation, and participate in jazz history/listening/ear training sessions.

- No jazz experience is needed.
- All ages accepted. Beginning, Intermediate, Advanced, and Adult groups each week.
- All concert band wind instruments, drum set, piano, bass, and guitar are accepted.
- There are no refunds, but transfers to another student are possible.
- Contact FM Kicks Band for reduced fees/hardship application.

Each week is four days long, Monday-Thursday from 9:00 -11:45 am at MSUM, Roland Dille Center for the Arts, Moorhead, MN. Early-bird tuition: \$300 by **May 4**, \$375 after **May 4** - pays for all 3 sessions. Optional noon-1:15 big band and Jazz jam sessions on M, T, & W are available for free.






